This traditional design Mayfly Corsaire has been in one ownership since new. She is presented in excellent condition.

Gaff cutter rigged with cream sails she has a traditional feel. When not rigged, the bow sprit stows on board in a tabernacle to reduce mooring costs. Her long keel with encapsulated

bilge fins allows her to take the ground. The hull has been treated with copper coat antifouling below the water line.

The engine is original and has done very little work, having only been run for 86 hours.

She comes with a wheeled storage trolley, as shown in photographs.

The cabin interior is attractively finished in wood. Portholes continue the traditional feel. There are three berths, two forward and one to port.

There is a separate heads compartment to starboard.

The galley has a sink with pressurised cold water and a portable gas stove.
